

ESDaP Diploma in Psychodermatology

General information

This diploma, granted by the European Society for Dermatology and Psychiatry (ESDaP) offers updated knowledge and develops essential competences to any person interested in psychodermatology. It consists of four modules, the first two provide basic information to all dermatologists or healthcare professionals working with skin patients. The last ones are ideal for professionals that are interested in becoming psychodermatologists or skin-psychologists/psychiatrists.

Who Can Apply?

Dermatologists, psychologists or psychiatrists working with patients who suffer from skin diseases. Other practitioners could be accepted on CV, if they are or would be involved in Psychodermatology.

Structure

The program consists of four modules. Because of the load of work, usually, the participants follow one course a year and we recommend it. However, participants may complete modules 1 and 2 or 3 and 4 successively in the same year.

Master Classes

Current or past participants benefit from free attendance to our annual Master class series in Psychodermatology. These events are organized as stand-alone one hour sessions, where world-class experts would explore specific topics of this fascinating discipline. This is an excellent opportunity to gain an understanding of the mind-skin connection and its complexity from a practical perspective.

Learning Objectives

Modules 1 and 2:

Recognize patient's problem	Ability that should be acquired

Patients needing psychotherapy	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Ability to recognize it and to send to a psychodermatologist or to a psychodermatology team
Patients with factitious disorders	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Ability to recognize it and to react on it

- Reinforce the abilities acquired during the previous two modules.
- Being able to recognize the frequent psychopathological conditions we encounter in psychodermatology and effectibley approach them.
- Counseling: starting interventions on the explicit asking

Evaluation System

The participant will have to complete assignments, some of which will have to be submitted beforehand and others during the course. Some assignments will be assessed by faculty members and others by peers.

Requirements

Participants must complete all required assignments in each course. All participants would receive a diploma of participation after finishing each level. In order to receive the proper certification, applicants must have to satisfy the following requirements for each level:

Modules 1 and 2

- ESDaP Congress attendance or 2 EADV Subspecialty Meeting attendance or 1 EADV Subspecialty + 1 APMNA, ADEPSI or national meeting (to be accepted before) or Publication of a scientific paper as a first author. The ESDaP Congress is held every 2 years.

Modules 3 and 4

- ESDaP Congress attendance or 2 EADV Subspecialty Meeting attendance or 1 EADV Subspecialty +1 APMNA, ADEPSI or national meeting (to be asked before acceptance) or Publication of a scientific paper as a first author
- Presentation or Poster at 1 ESDaP Congress
- Supervision 30 hours
- 3 written cases or 2 + 1 publication
